PURPOSE

We love providing a safe & neutral space for biological families to visit. Our space allows for flexibility, giving families the ability to schedule visits around work and school. Our space provides games, puzzles, toys, and creative options for parents and kids to play and bond.

THINGS TO KNOW

Our facility is opened, sanitized, and closed by a Foster Village Peoria Volunteer. They are not staff, and are not paid for their time. Please be respectful of the volunteers.

- Please arrive on time & clean up when the allotted time ends
- Please place toys that were played with on the table, so our volunteer knows which toys to sanitize after the visit.
- Throw away wrappers & trash from snacks or food.
- Only closed drink containers are allowed in the space (no open cups)
- Please be respectful while using the facility.

REMINDER: A *Supervisor* must be provided by agency or foster family. Our volunteer has not been trained & should not be involved in the visit or with individuals. Our volunteer will be in the Foster Village Office across the hall during the visit, per our contract agreement with University United Methodist Church. We do have a first aid kit available & can be requested if needed.

Foster Village Peoria reserves the right to deny future visits for individuals, if the rules & expectations are not followed, for the safety and respect for our volunteers. Thank you for understanding & being respectful.
